We're pleased to report that 2023 was a productive and successful year for the Provincetown Conservation Trust! Here's a sample of what we accomplished:

- At the close of the 2023, we were thrilled to receive a generous land donation from Fred Sateriale - a 2.2 acre waterfront parcel in the East End
- Published our first Spring/Summer newsletter
- Spearheaded a poll for naming "Warbler Woods" conservation parcel
- Hosted another successful Earth Day event, where 25+ volunteers collected litter from both town-owned and PCT conservation properties
- Hosted our first invasive species removal effort, removing garlic mustard from one of PCT's properties
- Hosted over a dozen free Nature Talks and Nature Walks for the Provincetown community
- Held our first-ever Nighttime Nature Walk, "Amphibians and Insects"
- Expanded our land stewardship program over the 110 acres of town and PCT conservation areas
- Elected two new trustees, Douglas Evans and Jane Weissman
- Elected Douglas Evans as Treasurer
- Thanks to your generous donations, we've begun building up our land protection fund to prepare for future land purchase and conservation opportunities

We're kicking off the year by increasing our news output with this Annual Report, and we hope you enjoy keeping abreast of our ongoing efforts. We look forward to sharing with you our diverse programming and the wonderful natural beauty of the tip of Cape Cod in 2024!

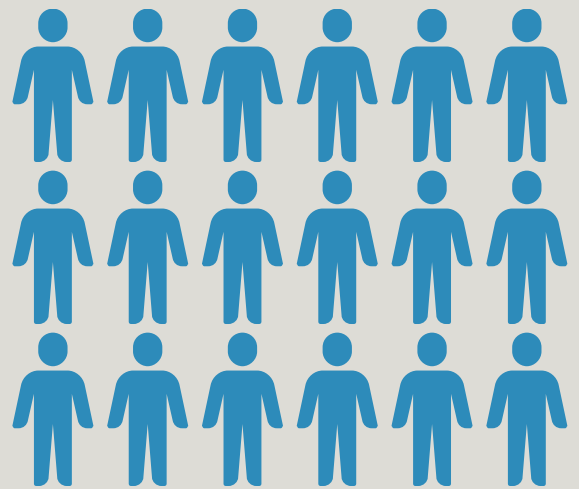

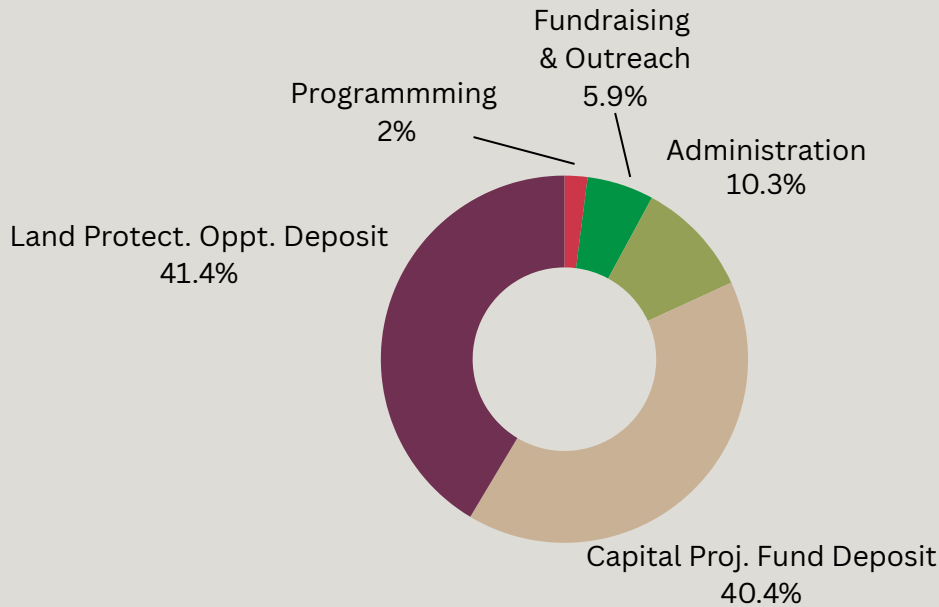

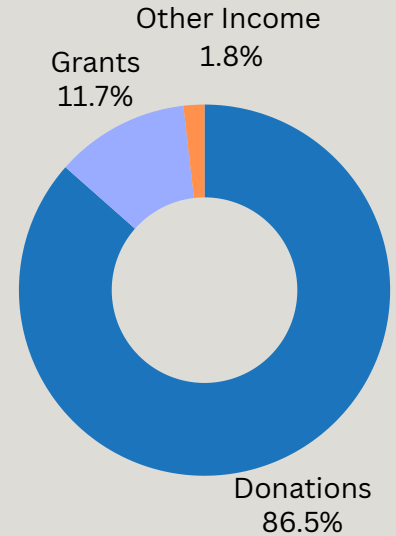
Financial Summary
